

Who am I in Christ?

Everyone who has received Jesus Christ as their one and only savior has not just chosen to receive Him, but they also need to choose to receive all the promises the Bible gives them. BECOME the one the Bible says you are...!! Do what Jesus tells you to do! Don't read about freedom, LIVE in freedom. Don't read about children of God, but BECOME a child of God, don't read about others being ambassadors for Jesus, but rather BECOME an ambassador for Him, etc.

You are in the light – delivered from the power of darkness – Colossians 1:12-14

You should give thanks to the Father who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light. He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.

You are one with Jesus – John 14:20

At that day you will know that I am in My Father, and you in Me, and I in you.

You are an ambassador for Christ – 2 Corinthians 5:20

Now then, we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God were pleading through us: we implore you on Christ's behalf, be reconciled to God!

You are a child of God – 1 John 3:1

Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of God! Therefore the world does not know us, because it did not know Him.

The spirit of God is within you – Romans 8:14-16

For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God. For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father." The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God.

You are holy before God – Colossians 1:21-22

And you ... He has reconciled in the body of His flesh through death, to present you holy, and blameless, and above reproach in His sight.

You were chosen to live for Christ – 2 Corinthians 5:15

He died for all, that those who live should live no longer for themselves, but for Him who died for them and rose again.

Have you been baptized (completely submerged), have you abandoned your OLD life? - Colossians 2:11-12

... you were ... buried with Him in baptism, in which you also were raised with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead.

You can put on Christ... so the devil doesn't see you, but rather Christ – Galatians 3:26-27

For you are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus. For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ.

You have received a new life in Christ – you will be seated next to Him – Ephesians 2:4-6

But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus.

You have been blessed with heaven's spiritual blessing – Ephesians 1:3

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in Christ.

You have been set free WITHOUT condemnation – Romans 8:1-2

There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who[a] do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.

You can handle anything, because Christ is in you – Philippians 4:13

I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.

You will do even greater works than Jesus did – John 14:12

Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father.

God has plans of peace for you – Jeremiah 29:11-14

For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope. Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart. I will be found by you, says the Lord, and I will bring you back from your captivity; I will gather you from all the nations and from all the places where I have driven you, says the Lord, and I will bring you to the place from which I cause you to be carried away captive.

Jesus is precisely for you who feels "oppressed". Luke 4:18-19

"The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed; To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord."

You are the temple of God – and God's spirit lives in you – 1 Corinthians 3:16-17

Do you not know that you are the temple of God and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? If anyone defiles the temple of God, God will destroy him. For the temple of God is holy, which temple you are.

You are chosen, loved, and holy – Colossians 3:12

Therefore, as the elect of God, holy and beloved, put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering.
